

YARC Weekly Net Control Station Guidelines

1. The file YARCnetscript.pdf contains the script for net control to use for the weekly YARC net.
2. The script may be downloaded from the club's Web site or passed on by the former month's NCS (Net Control Station).
3. The roster of check-ins will not be kept on the Web site. The practice has been for each month's NCS to pass on to the next month's NCS the list of stations that checked in at least once during a particular month. This practice was instituted in order to keep the check-in roster more current.
4. If you see a station on the roster and know that station is out of town, it is suggested you either call the station, or simply skip the station during roll call. It is strongly advised that you make no comments about the station being away from home. This is simply a security/privacy issue; there is no need to broadcast that someone is away from home as thieves and burglars have ears.
5. It is allowed to make changes to the script. If any NCS does make a change that he/she thinks should be carried forward, please have an updated PDF version placed on the club's Website by e-mailing the new script to our webmaster, WB6ODR, at lrsmith@cableone.net.

One easy way to convert any document/file to PDF is to download the free PDF converter PDF995: <http://www.pdf995.com/> PDF995 installs as a printer on your PC and allows you to simply print a file, text, graphics, etc., to it as a logical printer. The other option is to ask someone who already has PDF995, e.g. WB9VGJ or WA6ZZJ, to convert the file for you.
