The whole idea of setting up an antenna or station can be overwhelming and physically challenging. The YARC Elmer Group is here to help new hams get started. An Elmer is an Amateur Radio term used to describe a person or person(s) that mentor new hams. We first ask that you answer some questions so that we can better understand your needs.

During the installation of stations, the Elmers typically use supplies such as tape, wire ties, and other miscellaneous expendable items that are provided from their own personal supplies. To help defer these out of pocket costs, we ask you to consider an optional small donation. If you feel so inclined, please make your donation to the Yavapai Amateur Radio Club.

Note: With any outdoor antenna installation, it is critical to install adequate lightning protection in order to protect your property. All antenna installations must include lightning protection that is up to code.
